### **Social worker sues under state whistleblower law**

GOSHEN – A licensed social worker, who claims she was fired from her job at Campbell Hall Nursing Home, is suing the company claiming she was let go because she blew the whistle on the facility.

Nancy Von Ignatius' attorney Christopher Watkins said she was let go for talking to a state investigator.

She, as a social worker, met with a Department of Health investigator regarding a situation regarding patient care, an investigation into a particular patient's care there," Watkins said. "After speaking to the Department of Health within a few days, she was fired from her position and was told the reason she was fired was being fired was that she said too much to the Department of Health investigator."

That, said Watkins, is a violation of the state whistleblower law.

He is seeking back pay for his client, who was fired last May.
